ELIGIBILITY: Any youth-based group or club involving junior high and high school-aged students that does the majority of its work/service in the City of Ankeny.

NOMINATION: Nomination forms can come from any person wishing to nominate a youth club, regardless of residency, age or position. Completed forms can be taken to the Ankeny Parks & Recreation office located at 220 W 1st Street, or emailed in pdf form to rharkema@ankenyiowa.gov. Forms can also be found online at www.ankenyiowa.gov. Deadline is March 10.

JUDGING/WINNING: The Youth Club of the Year is selected by the Mayor’s Youth Council, based on their analysis of the nomination information. The winner will be notified and then publicly announced at the Youth Symposium on Saturday, April 15. The winning group will receive an award and have their name added to the Youth Club of the Year plaque located at Parks and Recreation.
